



HEALTH OFFICER ORDER **Order #2 COVID19** **Best Practices Supplement**

March 27, 2020

Businesses that are identified as essential /critical must limit access inside their doors.

1. Restaurants must only allow pickup (curb side) outside of business or by drive through window. Customers will not be allowed inside any restaurant; they must wait outside in their vehicle for their order.
2. All other stores, businesses, and establishments, shall limit attendance to TEN (10) people, exclusive of staff, with the following exceptions:
 - a. Rueb's SuperValu, Plentywood MT, will be limited to TWENTY (20) customers at one time.
3. All stores must limit one shopper per family.
4. Convenience Stores must limit access to their buildings and maintain 6-foot separation between customers. They also need to limit one person per family/vehicle to enter the store.
5. All other essential/critical businesses must also maintain the 6-foot requirement.

For purposes of enforcement, the County recognizes the logistical difficulties attendant to this sort of order. We will be relying on the good-faith cooperation of community partners to be compliant with this order. However, if non-compliance becomes habitual, penalties may be assessed as needed to enforce the order.
