



## HEALTH OFFICER ORDER Order #2 COVID19 - Extension Best Practices Supplement

April 12, 2020

### THE GOVERNOR'S EXECUTIVE ORDERS 2-2020 AND 3-2020 (PARTIAL):

Any person coming to Montana from another state or country for a non-work-related purpose must immediately self-quarantine for 14 days. If a person will be present in Montana for fewer than 14 days, that person must self-quarantine for the duration of the visit.

Essential work is defined under Section I, 11, "Essential Businesses and Operations."

### IN ADDITION TO THE GOVERNOR'S STAY-AT-HOME ORDER, THE SHERIDAN COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER ORDER #2 STATES:

- Persons who newly enter Sheridan County, resident or non-resident, including snowbirds
  - Persons who exited Sheridan County for any length of time for any reason that is not related directly to essential work, resident or non-resident.
  - New Essential Service Contractors staying for any amount of time
  - Persons passing through or staying for any amount of time
1. Must abide by the self-quarantine for a period of fourteen (14) days upon arrival.
  2. Must maintain six (6) feet of separation from all other people within the County.
  3. If a person will be present in Sheridan County for fewer than 14 days, that person must self-quarantine for the duration of the visit—but they can leave at any time.
  4. You may go to work if you are an essential employee, only interacting with other co-workers as needed, but separate from all others after work. However, employers are strongly encouraged to find another position within their establishment if the worker in question provides direct patient care or prepares food.
  5. You may use hotel lodging, outside gas pumps, curbside, drive up, or restaurant delivery, and laundry services /laundromats, then proceed on your journey without delay. You **may not** enter any essential service establishments including grocery, drug, or hardware stores during the 14-day quarantine but must utilize curbside service or delivery.
  6. A person who departs and then returns to Sheridan County will self-quarantine for another 14-day time period upon returning. This includes leaving the county prior to your essential services work being completed.
  7. During any period of self-quarantine, the individual subject to the same shall remain indoors to the greatest extent possible and shall limit all interactions with individuals. When interacting with any individuals, such interaction should occur in a way that accommodates at least six (6) feet of distance between the individuals.

### FURTHER EXPLANATION OF THE ORDERS:

1. Persons who qualify as essential workers are allowed to perform essential work within Sheridan County but must maintain six (6) feet of separation between all persons whenever it is possible to do so. Employers at essential businesses are strongly encouraged to find another position within their establishment if the worker in question provides direct patient care or prepares food.
- When a person new to Sheridan County within the last 14 days, resident or non-resident, is not performing essential work duties, strict self-quarantine is required.
- Persons who have not completed the 14-day self-quarantine are not to enter any place of business in Sheridan County to include grocery stores, service stations, and convenience stations. Outside gas pumping and purchase is allowed, with other purchasing accomplished using curbside delivery, delivery to the hotel, or online purchasing.
